BRIEF HISTORY

Founded in 1991 by Mr. and Mrs. Hundt in Menomonee Falls, WI, Aquinas Academy has flourished ever since. Due to growth and space needs the first building was purchased in 1993 at it's current location. From that point forward, Aquinas Academy established itself in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee as the preeminent leader in Catholic education. In 2015 Aquinas Academy had 101 students enrolled. Only two short years later, the school's student body has grown 20% to 122.

And that is only the beginning. Our forecast for the next school year is **132 students!** WHY ADD ON?


WHY ADD ON?

To take Aquinas Academy to the next level of excellence in Catholic education we need a new building added to the current facility to accommodate our growing community.

- The current facilities are perfect for the younger students, but lack the advanced classrooms and technology necessary for the continued development of the students as they grow older.
- •The full sized gymnasium and larger, specialized classrooms will allow us to overcome facilities limitations for middle school children which we experience in our current building.
- •The new addition is designed with additional classrooms, a science lab, art and music rooms, library, cafeteria, and a full-size gym.








2017 Iowa Test of Basic Schools Comparisons Currently Enrolled Students



MUSIC ROOM & ART STUDIO


